Regulations for COVID-19

To enter Croatia it is obligatory to have one of these options:

1. A negative PCR test not older than 48 hours.
2. Confirmation that a person has finished their vaccination at least 14 days prior to entering Croatia.
3. Confirmation for first round of vaccination and proof of already having and getting over COVID-19 – then there is no need for negative PCR test.

To maintain the safety and protection of all participants, the Organizing Committee asks all participants to follow this COVID-19 protocol. All members of the delegation must follow the health regulations established by the OC in accordance with instructions of the health authorities in the host country.

Mandatory:

- Masks are to be worn in all interior spaces, in outdoor areas where distance cannot be provided as well as in all official vehicles.
- Masks can only be taken off while eating.
 - o Athletes are allowed to take off the mask while in shooting position.
- It is required to change a mask few times per day, even with reusable masks.
- Physical distancing guidelines must be followed at all times (both open and closed spaces).
- The delegation is obliged to have an adequate supply of masks, hand sanitizers and gloves.
- Only athletes who are on the schedule to be on the line, according to the program, as well as their coach (only those with coach accreditation) are allowed in the shooting range during qualifications or training, along with the judges and technical staff of the Organizers.
- Upon display of any symptoms, members are obliged to seek medical attention then self-quarantine until obtaining a negative PCR.
- Teams are to register a responsible person to monitor compliance by members of the anti-COVID-19 protocol established by the ISSF and OC.
 - o The person who is chosen must inform the Organizers about suspicion of COVID-19 of their member as well as identify and inform the OC of members with whom the suspected member has been in contact with.
 - o Appropriate measures for isolation are to be taken if any member displays symptoms.

Entrance to the shooting range PAMPAS or the sports hall GRADSKI VRT will be available only to those with accreditation or limited number of invitations for the day only for domestic suppliers or service technicians that are in need to be at the complex periodically.

FINAL HALL:

- Currently the host country COVID-19 protocol does not allow spectators.
- If the local COVID-19 protocol allows spectators at the time of ECH, while respecting the distance, the number of spectators will be limited, and spectators of countries with finalists will have priority.

To further increase the safety of all participants, OC asks all participants the following:

- Athletes not to come to the shooting range on days when they do not have competition or training.
- During free time, while the athletes are not on schedule for competition or training, participants should stay in their hotel.
- To attend the organized lunch/dinner in hotel and avoid public space:

In case you need a PCR test to go home:

- Please announce 3 days before sampling at: epso2021@gmail.com
- The price of the PCR test is EUR 150.00
- Sampling will be every day from 07:00 to 08:00
 - o until 26.05.2021 in the sports hall GRADSKI VRT
 - o after 26.05.2021. at the PAMPAS shooting range

In case of symptoms compatible with COVID-19 appear while in Croatia:

1. Immediately wear a mask
2. Inform the responsible person in your team of your health condition as well as the reception at your hotel.
3. In coordination with the responsible person for monitoring compliance by members of team of the anti-COVID-19 protocol, arrange a PCR test.
4. If possible, move to a single room with dedicated bathroom.
5. It is important to self-isolate in this moment and respect the ban not to leave your room and follow the instructions of the health staff until obtaining a negative PCR test.
6. Follow respiratory hygiene and dispose tissues properly putting them in a double bag.
7. Be available at the daily calls of the health staff in charge of monitoring your health condition.
